Invitation to Worship & Lighting of the Advent Candle The Hodges Family

One: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

ALL: And also with you.

One: Last Sunday, we lit the first candle in our Advent Wreath, the candle of hope. We light it again as we remember that Christ, Who was born in Bethlehem, will come again to fulfill all of God's promises to us.

ALL: The second candle of Advent is the candle of peace. Peace is a word that we hear a lot. It is one of the things we hope for. Christ brought peace when He first came to us and He will bring everlasting peace when He comes again.

One: The prophet Isaiah called Christ "the Prince of Peace." When Jesus came He taught people the importance of being peace makers. He said that those who make peace shall be called children of God.

ALL: We light the candle of peace to remind us that Jesus is the Prince of Peace and that through Him, peace is found.

One: Peace is like light shining in a dark place. As we look at this candle, we celebrate the peace we find in Jesus Christ. Let's pray.
